Our New Building Project – Turning Dream into Reality

From the very beginning of this year, I, personally, along with Prof. Dr. Pramod Shrestha and Prof. Dr. Sangeeta Singh, have been very busy with the very ambitious plan of constructing a new building for Xavier Academy. Based on a very thorough and competitive design competition, Little More Studio (LMS) was awarded the 1st prize during the 27th Anniversary function and Fresher's Welcome program on 1st of August 2024. After a series of discussions and negotiations, the contract for designing the new building was signed on 26 September 2024 and the revised conceptual design was formally approved on 5 November 2024. The detailed design is in full swing with the design to be submitted for municipality approval at the end of the month and construction to start in the beginning of April 2025 and to be completed by the end of March 2027 for it to be formally inaugurated as part of the 30th Anniversary celebration on 1st of August 2027.






BBA INDUCTION
